(a) Initiative: <u>Participation in Events or Programs Sponsored by Educational</u> <u>Institutions Relating to Career Opportunities in Broadcasting</u>

i. Charlotte Hornets HBCU Panel and College Fair: January 19, 2024

The Employment Unit participated in the Charlotte Hornets Historically Black College and University (HBCU) Panel and College Fair with college bound high school juniors and seniors at the Spectrum Center. As HBCU alumni, they answered questions about their college experience, particularly at an HBCU school, discussed types of courses they took that lead them to their career in radio and the importance of internships and hands-on experience. They also emphasized the need to network and how to make connections, the challenges of college and goal setting for a successful career.

Students were invited to join the WPEG Morning Show on-air as their feature for their Teen Talk segment.

vi. iMeck Academy Career Development Program: January 31, 2024 - March 28, 2024

The Employment Unit visited iMeck Academy in Charlotte, NC to discuss the different career opportunities in radio. Members from the Sales, Digital, Graphic Design, On-Air, and Promotions departments talked to high school-level students about their experiences and career in radio. iMeck Academy is a multimedia magnet school that is the leading Digital Marketing Multimedia Design program in Charlotte Mecklenburg School system. iMeck's goal is to connect students with the passions that will drive their future careers; student performance thrives through creativity and unique experiences.

- January 31, 2024: Promotions Coordinator/Mix Show DJ visited the school to give students the experience to witness a DJ up close and personal. Students were allowed to enjoy music during their lunch period but also see his setup and how a DJ can create a unique mix and ask questions.
- February 21, 2024: The Employment Unit hosted a panel with members from the Sales, Digital, Graphic Design, On-Air, and Promotions departments to talk to high school students about their journey and their positions in radio. Each panelist answered questions about their background, their day-to-day duties in radio, and advised students on how to break into the industry. Students were also able to ask each panelist questions at the end during a Q&A segment.
- February 29, 2024: The Employment Unit who participated in the February 21st panel visited individual classes with smaller groups to work with each class in discussing their jobs more in-depth. Each class participated in activities with their panelist such as helping plan a mock event with promotions, discussing sales opportunities and how to close a deal, brainstorming local topic ideas for online content, discussing the importance of social media, how to interview a celebrity, and seeing the process of graphic designing in the radio industry.

viii. York County Amateur Radio Society & Pleasant Knoll Middle School - April 22, 2024

x. Station Tours
